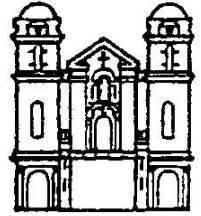

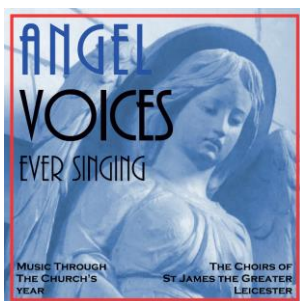

HOW TO MAKE A DONATION TO ST JAMES THE GREATER

It costs over **£350** a day (not including major building works) to run St James the Greater! Your gift is a vital contribution to the costs of ministry and maintenance of this fabulous place of worship. ***Please be as generous as your means allow.*** **You can donate in several ways:** if you are a UK tax payer, please complete a Gift Aid envelope (these are available in front of each seat); you can place a donation on the collection plate or in the wall safe at the rear of the Church; you can set up a standing order (call the Church Office for bank details) or you can join the Parish Giving Scheme (information on the back table). To make a donation by credit card please contact the Church Office during weekday mornings or speak to a Church Warden who has access to the card machine. ***Please ask a Church Warden/call the Church Office for further information.***
